- The Holy Spirit Is The Third Person (Member) Of The Divine Family** We recommend that you study TPBS Lesson #101, God – The Plural Nature Of Divinity. (1 Jn 5:7) “For there are _____ that bear record _____, the Father, the Word, and the _____: and these three are _____.” Each member of Divinity is *spirit* (Jn 4:24). One is no more, or less, *spirit* than another. They constitute the one _____ Family. All are God, therefore d____e.
- The Term “Holy Spirit” 3X In The KJV OT Scriptures?** _____ Indirect references to the Holy Spirit are numerous. Example: (Gen 2:1) “And the _____ moved upon the _____ of the waters.” In (Gen 8:1) “God made a _____ to pass over the _____, and the waters asswaged.” This is reference to the waters abating after the flood. The HEB word for *wind* is **ruwach** (roo'-akh) which can be understood as *spirit*. (Ps 33:6) “By the _____ of the LORD were the heavens _____; and all the host of them by the _____ of his mouth.” Note: The same HEB word translated *wind* (above) is *breath* here, and was *Spirit* in (Gen 2:1). Conclusion: The Holy Spirit is found often in the OT.
- The Holy Spirit Was Present In The Material Creation** (Gen 1:26) “And _____ said, Let _____ make man in _____ image, after _____ likeness.” Who is the *us* and *our* in this scripture? _____ Father, Son, and Holy Spirit are all God (ie: Divine).
