10. **What Does Titus 3:5 Actually Teach?** In (V1-3) Paul points to sins that are common to man. He then confirms that this is why God sent Jesus (V4). Man is sinful. Man has no individual goodness or power to effect his own salvation. He concludes (V5) that salvation is "*not by _____ which we have done*" but "*according to his _____ he saved us.*" Can a man be righteous apart from God? ____ Can he perform *righteous works* apart from God? _____
11. **What Does Ephesians 2:8-9 Actually Teach?** In (V1-7) the inspired writer explains that man was lost until The Father sent Jesus to die for our sins. In (V8) we are told that we are saved by _____. He adds that it is by _____ through _____. He says this *grace* is the _____. Grace simply means unearned (ie: unmerited) favor). It is undeserved. God has given us a means to salvation but we don't deserve it! He says, concerning man's inability to save himself (V9), "*Not of _____.*" Why?
