

6. **Nature & The Bible** All the laws of the science of natural things correspond and coincide exactly with the Bible. The animal, plant, and mineral kingdoms function as the Bible alleges and validates. Even doubters believed that (2 Pet 3:4), “for since the _____, all things _____ as they were from the _____ of the creation.” God stated (Gen 8:22), “While the earth _____, seedtime and _____, and cold and _____, and summer and _____, and day and _____ shall not cease.” Note that this is while the earth remains. The Bible predicts an eventual end: (2 Pet 3:10) “The _____ also and the _____ that are therein shall be _____ up.” Until then the natural laws so plainly stated in the Bible remain intact.
7. **The Good, The Bad, And The Ugly** Unlike human books, the Bible is unbiased. Early in his life it was said of David (1 Sam 13:14), “the LORD hath _____ a man after his _____.” (See also Acts 13:22). David was a great man of God, yet the Bible describes him as an *adulterer* and *murderer* at one point in his life (2 Sam 11). David never completely left God; he always repented. When Moses transgressed (Num 20) the Bible does not justify his actions. When Peter dissimulated (Gal 2:11-13) as he ate with Gentile Christians, Paul (V11) “withstood him _____, because he was to be _____.” The Bible is sometimes positive, sometimes negative. It came from God by the pens of His humble servants:

Whence but from heaven could men, unskilled in arts, In several ages born, in several parts,
Weave such agreeing truths; or how or why, Should all conspire to cheat us with a lie?
Unmasked their pains, ungrateful their advice, Starvation their gain, and martyrdom their price.
