

7. **Comparison: Continual Offerings – A One-Time Sacrifice** (Heb 10:11) “*And every \_\_\_\_\_ standeth \_\_\_\_\_ ministering and \_\_\_\_\_ oftentimes the \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifices, which can \_\_\_\_\_ take away sins*”. There was simply provision for forgiveness under the Old Covenant. This changed when Christ came and initiated the New Covenant through his death on the cross. (Heb 7:27) “*Who \_\_\_\_\_ daily, as \_\_\_\_\_ high priests, to \_\_\_\_\_ up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: \_\_\_\_\_, when he offered up \_\_\_\_\_.*” Note: “*For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin.*” Text? \_\_\_\_\_
8. **Comparison: Blood Of Animals – Blood Of Christ** (Heb 10:1, 4) “*For the \_\_\_\_\_ can never with those \_\_\_\_\_ which they offered \_\_\_\_\_ continually make the comers thereunto \_\_\_\_\_.*” (V4) “*For it is \_\_\_\_\_ that the blood of bulls and of goats should \_\_\_\_\_ sins.*” They offered by faith, looking to a better day. “*And these all, having obtained a good report through faith.*” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ (Heb 9:14) “*How much \_\_\_\_\_ shall the \_\_\_\_\_ of Christ, who through the \_\_\_\_\_ Spirit \_\_\_\_\_ without \_\_\_\_\_ to God, purge your conscience from dead works to \_\_\_\_\_ the living God?*”
9. **Comparison: Dead Vs Living Sacrifices** The writer plainly states the killing of animals in sacrifice was only a shadow of the ultimate price Jesus would pay. (Heb 10:3) “*But in \_\_\_\_\_ there is a \_\_\_\_\_ again made of sins \_\_\_\_\_.*” Paul wrote Christians to (Rom 12:1) “*\_\_\_\_\_ your bodies a \_\_\_\_\_ sacrifice, holy, \_\_\_\_\_ unto God, which is your \_\_\_\_\_ service.*” What kind of service? \_\_\_\_\_
10. **Comparison: Incomplete – Complete** It does us well to remember the word *perfect* means *mature, or complete in all parts.* (Heb 7:19) “*For the \_\_\_\_\_, but the bringing in of a \_\_\_\_\_ hope*” Paul stated that he, and faithful ministers, preached the gospel (Col 1:28), “*that we may present every man \_\_\_\_\_ in Christ Jesus.*”
11. **Comparison: Fleshly Circumcision – Spiritual Circumcision** This compares the body of the eight day old Jewish male to the Christian heart (mind). Review (Gen 17:9-12). (V11) “*And ye shall \_\_\_\_\_ the flesh of your foreskin.*” When? (V12) “*And he that is \_\_\_\_\_ old shall be circumcised among you.*” Paul wrote, speaking of spiritual Israel, (Rom 2:29) “*But he is a \_\_\_\_\_, which is one \_\_\_\_\_; and circumcision is that \_\_\_\_\_, in the spirit, and \_\_\_\_\_.*” Note: *circum = around, about* therefore circumcise means to cut around. Something is cut away. If it is fleshly circumcision, it is the flesh; if spiritual, it is worldliness. (Ezek 18:31) “*Cast away from you all your \_\_\_\_\_, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a \_\_\_\_\_ and a new spirit.*”
12. **Comparison: Condemnation – Righteousness** Paul compared the former and new covenants: (2 Cor 3:9) “*For if the \_\_\_\_\_ of condemnation be glory, much more doth the ministration of \_\_\_\_\_ exceed in glory.*” He says there is as much difference as day from night in the old and new covenants. “*For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.*” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_
