

7. **Whether Or Not He Was Baptized Is Really Immaterial** Jesus said, “*All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.*” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ In (Lk 5) Jesus had said to the man sick of palsy, “*Man, thy \_\_\_\_\_ are forgiven thee.*” The scribes and Pharisees (V21) questioned this statement. Jesus answered (V22-24), “*What \_\_\_\_\_ in your hearts? Whether is \_\_\_\_\_, to say, Thy sins be \_\_\_\_\_ thee; or to say, Rise up and walk? But \_\_\_\_\_ that the Son of man \_\_\_\_\_ upon earth to forgive sins.*” The key phrase is that Jesus had “*power upon earth to forgive sins.*” He was “on earth” at this time. He was “on earth” when he was yet alive on the cross. He was no longer on earth by Pentecost (Acts 2).
8. **Comparing Apples With Apples** One can no more argue the strictures of the NT applied under the OT than he can apply the physical properties of an apple to an orange. During the years Texas was an independent nation no citizen was required by law to pledge allegiance to the United States flag, but that changed when Texas became part of the United States. (Isa 5:20) “*Woe unto them that call \_\_\_\_\_ good, and good \_\_\_\_\_; that put darkness for \_\_\_\_\_, and light for \_\_\_\_\_; that put bitter for \_\_\_\_\_, and sweet for \_\_\_\_\_!*”

### **The Church Of The New Testament Is Undenominational**

9. **Denomination – A Definition** Webster: *A value or size of a series of values or sizes.* An example: One goes to the bank clerk and asks him to “break” a one hundred-dollar bill. The clerk replies, “*In what denomination do you want your bills?*” Correct exchange could be 5 – twenties; 10 tens; 20 fives; 2 twenties and 6 tens, etc. These bills have different values; they are of different denominations. The Lord pitched one “*true tabernacle.*” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_
10. **Many Churches – One Church** Denominationalism is antipodal to the Bible. The very term *denominational* illustrates this fact. Jesus said (Mt 16:18), “*I \_\_\_\_\_ my church*” (singular tense). Paul said, speaking of church members, (1 Cor 12:20) “*now are they \_\_\_\_\_ members, yet but \_\_\_\_\_ body.*”
11. **The Founder Is Important** Denominations are founded by men. Many wear the names of their human founders. Again, Jesus said, “*I will build my \_\_\_\_\_.*”
12. **Who’s The Boss?** We have no intention of being irreverent. Who is the “head” of the NT Church? Paul wrote, “*And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.*” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ Is Jesus really the (singular) “head” of your church? \_\_\_\_\_ Are you just fooling yourself? (1 Cor 2:8) “*Which none of the \_\_\_\_\_ of this world knew: for \_\_\_\_\_, they would not have \_\_\_\_\_ the Lord of glory.*”
13. **No Creed But The Bible** All scripture is given by the inspiration of God. Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ It contains “*all things that pertain unto life and godliness.*” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ Our denominational friends have *articles of faith, disciplines, catechisms*, etc. Why these necessary if the Bible is complete and all sufficient? \_\_\_\_\_ What does the Bible say to those who add or subtract from God’s word (Deut 4:2)? \_\_\_\_\_
