- The False Doctrine Of Premillennialism** We recommend that you carefully study TPBS Lesson [#41](#) The Kingdom Of God, [#72](#) Premillennialism Part I and [#75](#), Premillennialism Part II. Premillennialism embraces a future kingdom theory that calls for a literal 1,000 year earthly reign of Christ in Jerusalem. Any doctrine that contradicts the Bible is \_\_\_\_\_.
- The Prophecy Of (Daniel 2:44)** Daniel, in giving the interpretation of Nebuchadnezzar's forgotten dream said, "*in the days of \_\_\_\_\_ shall the God of heaven \_\_\_\_\_, which shall \_\_\_\_\_ destroyed.*" These kings were the kings of the Roman Empire – the Caesars. If it was to "*never be destroyed*" that means it would last \_\_\_\_\_.

- The World's Oldest Man** The Bible says, "*And all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred sixty and nine years: and he died.*" Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ If the kingdom hasn't been established yet people nearly 2,000 years old would be living now. Can you imagine that? \_\_\_\_\_
- Jesus Expected His Disciples To Enter The Kingdom** He said to them (Mt 18:3), "*Except ye be \_\_\_\_\_, and become as \_\_\_\_\_, ye shall not enter into the \_\_\_\_\_ of heaven.*" Why press the point if the kingdom was yet 2,000 years in the future? \_\_\_\_\_
- His Statement To The Seventy** "*The kingdom of God is come nigh unto you.*" Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ Did Jesus really mean it was "*at hand*" or "*come nigh unto*" them? \_\_\_\_\_ The word *nigh* means near. He spoke these words two millenniums ago.
- Jesus: The Last Supper** (Lk 22:18) "*For I say unto you, I will \_\_\_\_\_ of the fruit of the \_\_\_\_\_, until the kingdom of God \_\_\_\_\_.*" This would be the last observance of the Passover before the \_\_\_\_\_ came.
