(Rom 5:9) “Being now justified by _____, we shall be _____ from wrath through him.”
14. **Justified – In The Name Of Jesus Christ** This authority is the *immediate agent*. (1 Cor 6:11) “Ye are justified _____ the Lord Jesus.” (Acts 4:12) “For there is _____ under heaven _____, whereby we must be saved.”
15. **Justified – By Faith** This is the *human agent*. (Rom 5:1) “Therefore being _____ by faith.” Saving faith is demonstrated in trust and obedience. Samuel told Saul: (1 Sam 15:22) “Behold, to _____ is better than sacrifice, and to _____ than the fat of rams.”
16. **Justified – By Works Of Obedience** Man cannot be righteous of himself. Man’s works apart from God cannot save him (Titus 3:5).
