

9. **An Abomination** God has (2 Pet 1:3) “given unto us _____ things that pertain unto _____ and _____.” When men choose to adopt their own system “they are far from thy law.” Scripture? _____ God’s law of pardon is established. He will not set it aside just because man wants to take “short-cuts” or do something different. (Prov 28:9) “He that _____ his ear from _____, even his _____ shall be abomination.” This applies to those who choose not to follow the apostolic examples and commands of Jesus.
10. **An Example: Natural Law** Jesus taught the disciples to pray (Mt 6:11), “Give us this _____ our daily _____.” Natural law is to break the ground, plant the seed, cultivate the crop, and then reap the harvest. Suppose a man prays to God for a bounty of food but refuses to follow natural law? Will God miraculously provide food to the sluggard, or the fool? _____ Why should we think that we will be blessed if we refuse to follow God’s spiritual law? Salvation from sins is not received by “praying through” at the mourner’s bench. There is no such NT example.
11. **God’s Law Of Pardon To The Alien Sinner** (a) **Believe** (Jn 8:24) “If ye believe _____ that I am he, ye shall _____.” (b) **Repent** (Lk 13:3) “Except ye _____, ye shall all likewise _____.” (c) **Confess** (Mt 10:32) “Whosoever therefore shall _____ before men, him will I confess also _____ my Father which is in heaven.” (d) **Be Baptized** for remission of sins. (Acts 22:16) “And now why _____ thou? arise, and _____, and _____ thy sins.” We can pray all we want; read the Bible for hours each day; fold our hands and lower our eyes, but if we circumvent God’s law it is an abomination to Him. NT doctrine does not teach anywhere that one is saved at the point (moment) of faith.

13. **Does God Hear The Alien Sinner’s Prayer For Salvation (Jn 9:31)?** (a) God is *omniscient*, which means He is “all-knowing.” (b) We identify the *alien sinner*: one who is not a child of God. (c) We know that only Christians receive *spiritual blessings* (Eph 1:3). (d) One who hasn’t been “born again” has no Heavenly Father, or Savior, to pray *to* and *through*. (Jn 9:31) “Now we know that _____: but if any man be a _____ of God, and _____, him he heareth.” How much plainer could it be?
14. **Two – Or More – Ways To Be Saved?** Peter told Cornelius (Acts 10:34), “Of a truth I perceive that God is no _____ of persons.” God doesn’t have one plan to save one group and another plan to save another group. Prayer is a wonderful and powerful thing. It is the means whereby His children communicate with Him. (1) Prayer is not in God’s law of pardon for the alien sinner. (2) Prayer is definitely an integral part of God’s law of pardon for His erring child (Acts 8:22).
