

7. **Where Is God's Family?** They may be located almost anywhere geographically. That's not the question. (2 Cor 6:18) "Will be a \_\_\_\_\_ unto you, and ye shall be my \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_, saith the Lord Almighty." Paul wrote Timothy (1 Tim 3:15): "That thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the \_\_\_\_\_ of God, which is the \_\_\_\_\_ of the living God." The church is also referred to as (Gal 6:10) the "\_\_\_\_\_ of faith." Luke meant that the family feared God when he said (Acts 10:2) that Cornelius, "feared God with all \_\_\_\_\_." It is plain that *God's family* is in *the house of God*, which is the \_\_\_\_\_.
8. **Illegitimate Family Members?** Is God guilty of begetting "stray" or illegitimate children? Would not this be the equivalent of spiritual adultery? Would you want to argue that God has "stray children" that are not of his family? \_\_\_\_ Do not many religious bodies teach that there are Christians both "in" and "out of" their churches? \_\_\_\_ Jesus said (Jn 10:16): "Other sheep I have, which are not of this fold: \_\_\_\_\_, and they shall hear my voice; and there shall be \_\_\_\_\_, and \_\_\_\_\_." The Gentiles were made equal and legitimate heirs with the Jews shortly after Jesus uttered these words. It was validated *de jure* on Pentecost Day (Acts 2) and was accomplished *de facto* with the conversion of Cornelius (Acts 10). Every child of God is in his church.
9. **Salvation & Church Membership Is Inextricably Linked To Baptism** Immersion in water washes away sins (Acts 22:16), thereby it saves (1 Pet 3:20-21). Notice what else baptism does: (1 Cor 12:13) "For by one Spirit are we all baptized \_\_\_\_\_ one body." Paul said (Eph 4:5) that there is but "one \_\_\_\_\_." Christ (Col 1:18) "is the head of the \_\_\_\_\_, the \_\_\_\_\_." Conclusion: Scripturally baptized people are in the church because they are baptized into the body, the church. They constitute the saved. All the saved (ie: scripturally baptized) are in the church.
10. **Is The NT Church An Invisible, Mystical "Something" That No Human Can Comprehend?** Many contend the saved must be in the church but that it is so indiscernible and unfathomable that it is impossible for mere humans to know where it begins or ends, or whom it enfolds. The 3,000 were baptized (Acts 2:41) and added to the church (V47). We know (Acts 10:34), "that God is no \_\_\_\_\_ of persons." If God only added the baptized back then, that's all he adds now. It was visible. "At that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem." Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ Give three NT examples of "the church" at certain places.

11. **Salvation Is Impossible Without Deliverance From The Darkness Of Sin** (Col 1:13) "Who hath \_\_\_\_\_ us from the power of \_\_\_\_\_, and hath translated us into the \_\_\_\_\_ of his dear Son" They were "delivered" (past tense) into the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_. Did Christ's kingdom exist in NT times? \_\_\_\_ Christ is king over his kingdom. It is a spiritual kingdom (Jn 18:36). Christ is "head" of the church (Eph 5:23). The two words are used interchangeably (Mt 16:18-19). Jesus is *king* over Christians who are his subjects in his kingdom. Jesus is the *head* of Christians who comprise the church (ie: the called out of the darkness of sin). If one is not in the kingdom (NT Church) he cannot be saved because he has not been *translated* or *called out* of a sinful state.
