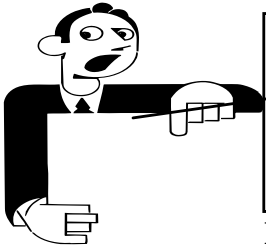


7. **MARK #5 We cannot serve two masters simultaneously.** (Mt 6:24) “\_\_\_\_\_ serve two masters---Ye cannot serve \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.” Paul said: (2 Cor 11:2) “For I am \_\_\_\_\_ over you with \_\_\_\_\_ jealousy: for I have espoused you to \_\_\_\_\_ that I may present you as a \_\_\_\_\_ to Christ.” The church, comprised of individual Christians—(1 Cor 12:27), is the bride of Christ (Jn 3:29; Eph 5:22-32). If members *compromise* themselves with the devil, they commit *spiritual fornication*. (Jas 4:4) “Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know ye not that \_\_\_\_\_ is enmity with God? whosoever---will be a \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ is the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.”
8. **MARK #6 We must love God -- not the world** (1 Jn 2:15-17) “Love not the \_\_\_\_\_, neither the things that are in the \_\_\_\_\_.
