## SCRIPTURALLY BASED INSTRUCTION FOR THE CHRISTIAN – LESSON 28 DON'T COPY OTHERS – MEASURE YOURSELF – DON'T FORGET

- Every Person Must First Account For Their Own Lives** (Phil 2:12) “\_\_\_\_\_ your own \_\_\_\_\_ with \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.” Some erroneously interpret this verse to mean that one must determine what “brand” of religion suits him and pursue it. (a) Each man must attend himself, not another. (b) He must obey (Rom 6:17) “From the \_\_\_\_\_ that form of \_\_\_\_\_ which was delivered you.” (c) By “delivered” this means the Law of Christ in the NT. (c) In “working out” his salvation, one must (2 Cor 13:5) “\_\_\_\_\_ yourselves, whether ye be \_\_\_\_\_; \_\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_\_ selves.” You will be judged by what you do, not what others do.

- The Fallacy Of Comparing Oneself To Others** (2 Cor 10:12) “For we \_\_\_\_\_ not---compare ourselves with some that \_\_\_\_\_ themselves: but they \_\_\_\_\_ themselves by themselves, and \_\_\_\_\_ themselves \_\_\_\_\_ themselves, \_\_\_\_\_.” Why? \_\_\_\_\_ The Pharisee in (Lk 18) compared himself to a publican: (V11) “God, I \_\_\_\_\_, that I \_\_\_\_\_ as other men are, extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or \_\_\_\_\_ as this \_\_\_\_\_.” Where did he go wrong? \_\_\_\_\_
- Christ Is Our Example – Our Pattern** (1 Pet 2:21) “Christ also \_\_\_\_\_ for us, leaving us an \_\_\_\_\_, that ye should \_\_\_\_\_ his \_\_\_\_\_.” Jesus taught: (Jn 12:48) “The \_\_\_\_\_ that I have \_\_\_\_\_, the same shall \_\_\_\_\_ him in the \_\_\_\_\_.” The Apostle Paul said, “Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ.” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_
- Everybody Must Personally Meet Christ’s Standard** (Gal 6:4) “But let every man \_\_\_\_\_ his \_\_\_\_\_, and then shall he have \_\_\_\_\_ in himself alone, and not in \_\_\_\_\_.”
