

8. **Example #6: Confusion About Scriptural Baptism** (a) Many think if they were baptized at some point in their lives that they are qualified for acceptance into any church, regardless its religious flavor. (b) There is (Eph 4:4) but “one \_\_\_\_\_” which is (Col 1:18) “the \_\_\_\_\_.” (c) If one is ever scripturally baptized for remission of sins the Lord (Acts 2:47) \_\_\_\_\_ that person to the \_\_\_\_\_. (d) God only adds (ibid) those “such as \_\_\_\_\_ be \_\_\_\_\_.” (e) Obviously those baptized for any reason other than remission of sins have not been “added” by God.
9. **Example #7: Confusion About Scriptural Baptism** (a) Many think one is saved, based on his faith alone, before baptism. If so, he is saved before he is spiritually born. (b) Why? Jesus said: (Jn 3:5) “Except a man be \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.” (c) The new creature doesn’t exist until the birth takes place. (d) (Rom 6:4) “Therefore we are \_\_\_\_\_ with him by \_\_\_\_\_ into \_\_\_\_\_: that like as Christ was \_\_\_\_\_ from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_.”
10. **Example #8: Confusion About Spiritual Baptism** (a) Some think there is something magical in the baptismal water. This is silly! (b) Water, any kind of water, is simply the specified element (1 Pet 3:20-21) for immersion. (c) It may be fresh, brackish, salty, hot, cold, still, or running water. (d) Those who presume the water has mystical power don’t want to acknowledge the absolute necessity of the individual being a “penitent” sinner who understands that the purpose of baptism is *to wash away his sins*. (e) “Holy water” is a figment of the imagination! One must (Rom 6:17) have “\_\_\_\_\_ from the \_\_\_\_\_ that form of \_\_\_\_\_” found in the NT.
11. **Can Everyone Be Scripturally Baptized? NO!** (a) The vast majority of the human population will never seriously believe and repent in order to qualify. (b) Infants and mentally unaccountable adults cannot qualify. (c) A drunken man requesting baptism would have to be refused. (d) I would never immerse anyone who refused to answer as did the eunuch: (Acts 8:37) “I \_\_\_\_\_ that Jesus Christ \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ of God.” ~Ed~ Scriptural baptism is inarguably the most important occasion in one’s life.
12. **The Insincerely Immersed Must Be Re-baptized** (a) Anyone who reflects back and knows that they “came forward” for baptism based strictly on emotion, because of peer pressure, or for any other anti-scriptural reason must be re-baptized – if they are to receive salvation. (b) NT baptism involves “the answer of a good \_\_\_\_\_ toward God.” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_
13. **Those Baptized For The Wrong Reason Must Be Scripturally Baptized** (a) This happened (Acts 19). Paul found certain disciples (V3) who knew only “John’s \_\_\_\_\_” years after the NT Church was established in Jerusalem (Acts 2). (b) John’s baptism was preparatory to the cross and the NT Church, and had long since expired. (c) Paul taught them. (V5) “They were \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus.” (d) This is a wonderful Bible example for anyone today who has doubts and fears and wants to “get it right.”
14. **Getting It Right – Or Just Getting Wet** (a) If one’s first baptism was scriptural but that person had questions and was re-baptized for the right reason the second time – he just got wet. (b) But if the first baptism wasn’t “right” then he wasn’t really ever scripturally baptized at all and needed re-baptism to save him from past sins and place him “in Christ.” (c) Would you jeopardize your soul by refusing re-baptism in face of questions about your former baptism? \_\_\_\_ (d) “Give diligence to make your calling and election sure.” Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_
