8. **Consistency In Partaking The Lord’s Supper** Paul defines an assembling (1 Cor 11) to (V26-27) “*eat this _____, and drink this _____ of the Lord*” and clearly commands (V33) that “*when ye _____ to eat, _____ one for another.*” In addition we have the Apostolic example at Troas (Acts 20) of Christians assembling (V7) “*together to _____ bread.*” Is the love of God in my heart aptly expressed when I deliberately choose to spend my time doing something else when “other” assemblies of the local church are being conducted?
9. **Consistencies In My Attention Span** I can watch endless hours of sports programming, news, and drama series, or surf the internet half the night. Am I equally consistent when worship services run “a little over,” fall on a night when I’m tired, have a recreational function, or just want to “baby” myself? Christians must say with David (Ps 111:1), “*I will _____ the LORD with my _____ heart, in the _____ of the upright, and in the congregation.*”
10. **Consistencies In My Good Works** It is easy to “give” to those we like, regardless of need, but much harder to give to a stranger truly in need. Remember the story Jesus told of the “neighborly” Samaritan (Lk 10:30-37)? 13. **Consistency In My Work Ethic** (a) Paul was plain: (2 Thess 3:10) “*When we were with you, this we _____ you, that if any would _____, neither should he _____.*” (b) Christians (1 Cor 3:9) must be “*_____ together _____ God.*” Do I abuse my secular job by tardiness, absenteeism, and an inconsistent work ethic? If so, this is not Christ-like. Do I sometimes “get on fire” for the Lord, then go through periods of lassitude and slothfulness? Jesus said: (Lk 9:62) “*No man, having put his _____ to the _____, and looking _____, is _____ for the kingdom of God.*” What happens if we die while “*looking back*”?
14. **Consistency In Friendliness And Approachability** We know folks who let their “feelings” dictate their attentiveness and friendliness. They “let down” when they feel out of sorts, depressed, or when meteorological “low pressure” allows their “animal nature” to take over.
