

7. **Paul’s Last Mention Of Troas** (2 Tim 4:13) “The _____ that I left at Troas with _____, when thou _____, bring with thee, and the _____, but especially the _____.”

The Church at Cenchrea (52 or 53 AD)

8. **Cenchrea – In Corinth (Greece)** Cenchrea the eastern port city of Corinth. Phoebe served in the church there (Rom. 16:1) and Paul, or Aquilla, had his head shaved there because of a vow (Acts 18:18). Apparently Paul established this church. (Rom 16:1) “I commend unto you Plebe our _____, which is a _____ of the church which is at Cenchrea.” The GK *diakonos* for *servant* is also the word (1 Tim 3:8) for deacons. The word generally means a *servant*.
9. **More Information** We learn a bit more in (Acts 18:18). “And sailed thence into _____, and with him _____ and _____; having _____ his head in Cenchrea: for he had a vow.” Note: Many commentators think Aquilla, not Paul, had his head shaved. It is really immaterial. This was an imitation of the Nazarite Vow. During the vow the hair was uncut, but the head was shaved afterward. Apparently it was done for conscience’s sake. See Num 6; Judges 13 & 16
