THE CHURCHES OF CRETE A large island in the Mediterranean, SE of the Greek mainland, about 160 miles long and up to 30 miles in width. Archaeology on Crete has uncovered the history and remains of the ancient Minoan civilization, which arose, flourished, and declined on the island during the Bronze Age (about 2600-1125 B.C.). The island of Crete was made a Roman province in the 1st century B.C. Probably same as Caphtor, the original homeland of the Philistines. Acts 27:7-13; Acts 27:21; Tit 1:5 (Copied ~Ed~)
