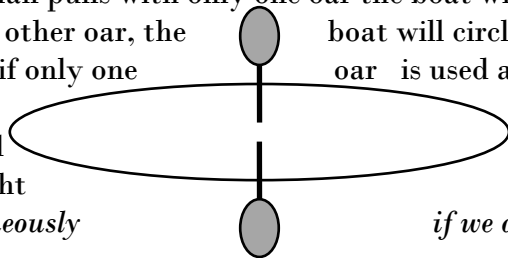


**A Simple Illustration:** Imagine this is a rowboat. One oar is the “oar of faith” and the other the “oar of works”. If the oarsman pulls with only one oar the boat will go in a circle. If he then rests that oar, and pulls with the other oar, the boat will circle in the opposite direction. So, no matter which oar is used, if only one oar is used at the time, the boat will always circle and never make any forward progress. Now, if both oars are plied with equal force the boat will be propelled forward on a straight course. So it is that faith and works must exist simultaneously if we are to please God.
