- Simon The Sorcerer** In the same context we are told specifically of Simon, a _____. What verse tells how Simon reacted to Philip’s preaching? ____ What little four-letter word assures us that his conversion was *bona fide*? ____ Simon had problems after his baptism. Peter told him (Acts 8:22), “____ therefore of this thy wickedness, and _____ God, if perhaps the thought of thine heart may be _____ thee.” Repentance (ie: a change of attitude) must come before baptism; it is also necessary after baptism whenever a child of God sins. Simon’s conversion was sincere but he soon sinned. Is so quick a transgression unique only to Simon? ____ We must be patient with new converts but not condone their shortcomings. Always demand repentance.
