

JOSHUA - THE CONQUEST OF CANAAN

10. **An Update** The entire _____ chapters of the book of Joshua and the first chapter of Judges tell of the conquering of Canaan. The original exodus (ie: the leaving from) Egypt is narrated in the book of Exodus and likely took place about 1280 BC. If this date is correct, the conquest took place 1240-1190 BC. After about 250 years of dominion, Egypt's control over Canaan was slipping. The kings of city-states had long paid heavy tribute to the Egyptians. The coastal region was populous; the mountainous regions were sparsely inhabited. The hostile inhabitants were the Canaanites, Hittites, Hivites, Perizzites, Gergashites, Amorites, and the Jebusites.

Alarmed by this alliance, a group of southern Canaanite kings, led by Adoni-zedek of Jerusalem, formed a coalition. The kings threatened to attack the Gibeonites, causing Joshua to come to their defense. Joshua's forces were victorious. Where does the Bible say, "*for the LORD fought for Israel*"? _____
