## THE LORD'S SUPPER – LESSON 1

1. **Only Paul Uses The Expression “Lord’s Supper”** (1 Cor 11:20) “When ye come \_\_\_\_\_ therefore into \_\_\_\_\_, this is not to eat the Lord’s supper.” How many other times does Paul use the expression “the Lord’s supper”? \_\_\_\_\_ What other terms (names) define it? Give textual locations: \_\_\_\_\_
2. **The OT Forerunner Is The Passover** The Passover, one of three major Jewish feasts, was observed in remembrance of the final plague on Egypt. The Egyptian firstborn died; the Israelites were spared because of (Ex. 12) the blood they applied to their doorposts. The “destroyer” passed over them. What kind of bread was to be eaten? \_\_\_\_\_ For how long?
3. **Jesus Was Crucified During The Passover** (Lk 22:1) “Now the \_\_\_\_\_ of unleavened \_\_\_\_\_ drew nigh, which is called the \_\_\_\_\_.” Jesus sent \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_ to make preparations for observance of the feast. Scripture? \_\_\_\_\_ When the time came (Lk 22:14ff) Jesus and the apostles met in an \_\_\_\_\_ room and ate what is commonly known as the \_\_\_\_\_ Supper. During this meal (Luke 22:7, 19-20) Jesus said, “This is my \_\_\_\_\_,” and “this cup is the \_\_\_\_\_ in my blood.” Jesus truly was (Rev 13:8) the “Lamb \_\_\_\_\_ from the foundation of the world.” In other words, he is (1 Cor 5:7) the \_\_\_\_\_ lamb.

6. **The Blood Of The NT Lamb Must Be Applied** As the OT lamb was killed, so Jesus was killed. The Jews, knowing the next day was the Sabbath (Jn 19:31), sought permission to break the legs of the three crucified men. (Jn 19: 33-34) “But when they came to \_\_\_\_\_, and saw that he was \_\_\_\_\_, they brake not his legs: But one of the \_\_\_\_\_ with a \_\_\_\_\_ pierced his side, and forthwith came there out \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_.” Did Jesus shed His blood while alive, or after He was dead? \_\_\_\_\_ This is important! He shed his blood in his death.
