- The Consequences Of Wrongful Participation** (1 Cor 11:28-29) “But let a man _____ himself, and so let him ____ of that bread, and drink of that _____. For he that eateth and drinketh _____, eateth and drinketh _____ to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.” Eats and drinks what? _____ Damnation because he fails to do what? _____
