7. **The Church Of God** The church of the NT has no proper name. It is described in as many ways as necessary to make a point or to showcase some function. The phrase “church of God” is found 8X in the KJV. “Unto the church of God which is at _____.” Scripture? _____. This shows ownership. Note: We may call ourselves anything we wish but it is only when our doctrinal practice is consistent with the NT that we are God’s church.
8. **The Churches Of Christ** (Rom 16:16) “The churches of _____ you.” The plural use denotes it is being used in a local or congregational sense. Several churches of Christ are simply a plurality of churches, whereas one such church would be a church of Christ. Again, this phrase is possessive and shows that it is _____’s church. Note: You may notice church buildings with signs that read “The _____ CHURCH OF CHRIST MEETS HERE.” That’s as it should be. The building is a house only. The church is the people. They “meet here.” While the NT Church has no set proper name, the descriptive phrase Church of Christ is very scriptural.
